DEFENDING CHAMPION OF THE SPRING NATIONAL SPRINT CAR CHAMPIONSHIP



SAMMY SWINDELL — MEMPHIS, TENNESSEE
Born 1956

1971 — Started racing "B" Modifieds in July, 1971. 15 Years Old. Won 11 feature events that year. Finished 5th in points at West Memphis, Arkansas. (Riverside Speedway).

1972 — Began driving first Sprint Car. Won 28 feature events in the Modifieds. Was Delta Sportsmen Association Modified Champion in '72. Finished 5th in points at West Memphis (Modifieds).

1973 — Won 16 Modified features. Finished 2nd in points at West Memphis in the Modifieds. Was 5th in points in the Sprint Division.

1974 — Set NEW TRACK RECORD in Sprints at West Memphis—14.02 (was 14.25 held by Bubby Jones) on May 19. On May 25, set NEW TRACK RECORD in Sprints at 13.92. He was the first man to ever turn West Memphis in 13 seconds. On June 2, NEW TRACK RECORD in Sprints at 13.71

Knoxville Nationals — Won his heat, finished 11th in the "B" Main.

Western States in Phoenix — 5th in Consolation Race. Pacific Coast Championship at Ascot Park, he was 3rd in the heat, was running 6th in the "A" Main and fell out with engine problems.

Won the World Short Track Championship at West Memphis for Sprint Cars.

Won 12 Modified Features, 11 Sprint Features. Won both the Sprint and Modified points at West Memphis. He was the first man ever to win both Sprint and Modified in the same year.

1975 — Set NEW TRACK RECORD in Modifieds at West Memphis—14.55 on July 3. Won the World Short Track Championship for the second year in a row. Made a clean-sweep at Stuart, Iowa the week of the Knoxville Nationals running against drivers such as Jan Opperman.

Knoxville Nationals — Won the "C" Main. Won the Modified and Sprint Car Points at West Memphis for the 2nd year in a row. Won the Sprint Points in the Delta Racing Association at Greenville, Mississippi. Won 22 Sprint Features, 15 Modified Features. Won features in 5 states.

1976 — Set NEW TRACK RECORD in Sprints at Long Beach, Mississippi—16.12 on March 26.

NEW TRACK RECORD in Modifieds at West Memphis—14.35 (was 14.55) on May 29.

NEW TRACK RECORD in Sprints at West Memphis—13.66 (was 13.71) on May 29.

Sprint Nationals at Dallas, Texas — Won "B" Main, 9th in "A" Main.

Won an All-Star Feature at Eldora, Ohio.

Knoxville Nationals — Was the youngest driver to make the "A" Main. Timed 9th, started 18th in the Main, finished 11th.

Qualified 3rd in Cajon Nationals at Shreveport. Won heat, 2nd Feature. Qualified the fastest at West Capital, Gold Cup Championship, at Sacramento, Calif., won heat, 2nd in Feature.

Set Fastest qualifying time of the meet at Manzanita in the Western States Championship. Was leading his heat and some oil caught on fire causing him to pull out. Was given the Hark Luck Trophy. Qualified 5th fastest in the Pacific Coast Championship at Ascot Park. Won the heat (Set NEW TRACK RECORD for Heat), Finished 2nd in the "A" Main. Won 13 Modified features, 14 Sprint features. Won both the Sprint and Modified Points at West Memphis for the 3rd year in a row. Traveled to 12 states and won features in 10 of them.

1977 — Won the Dallas Spring Nationals in March setting fast time and winning the heat. Made a clean-sweep at Oklahoma City in their Spring Nationals. Won the Big Muddy Spring Nationals at West Memphis. Won 3 out of 4 Spring National events which were held in March.

Qualified 4th fastest in the Missouri Sprint Nationals on Saturday. Finished 2nd in the main event.

Qualified 2nd fastest on Friday night. He was the 2nd Place Over-All Winner for two nights of racing. Made a clean-sweep at West Capital Speedway in Sacramento, Calif. June 24.

Won the Eldon Forrester Invitational at Des Moines, Iowa in July. Set NEW TRACK RECORD for a 10 Lap Heat Race at Des Moines.

Won the Over-All Championship in Sprints at Denver, Colorado in July. Won both feature events.

Drove a R.M.M.C.A. MIDGET in Denver and won his first feature and trophy dash. This was the first time in a Midget.



Over-All Champion in the Midget Division (Won 1, 2nd in another). Jerry Weld Memorial — 1st in the feature event on Friday night, finished 2nd in both main events on Saturday. Won the Feature Event at Lincoln Speedway two separate times. (Lincoln, Nebraska). Knoxville Nationals — 3rd Fastest Qualifier. Finished 2nd in the "C" Main, Won the "B"

Main, 9th in the "A" Main. Came through every feature to qualify for the Main Event.

Set NEW TRACK RECORD at Skagit Speedway in Alger, Washington, June 16—14.086.

Set NEW TRACK RECORD at West Memphis—13.47 (was 13.66) July 23.

Won 12 out of 16 features at West Memphis in the Modifieds. Started 51 Sprint Events and won 30 of them. Traveled to 16 States so far and won Main events in 13 of them.

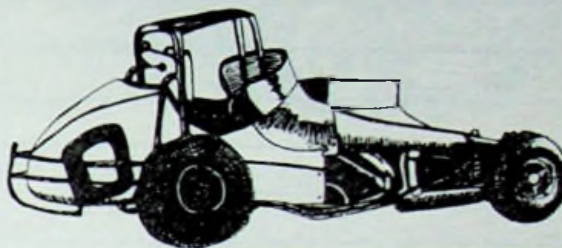

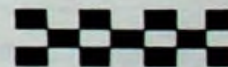
