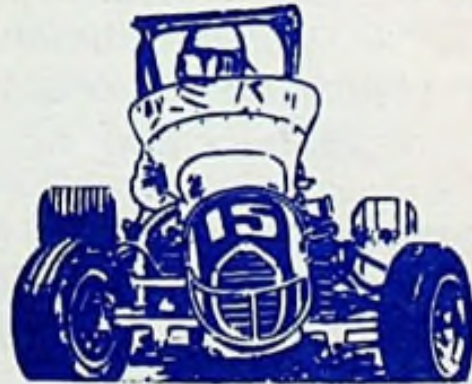

RON SHUMAN SEEKS TO EXPAND CRA LEAD, FOURTH PCN WIN

Ron Shuman of Tempe, Ariz. suddenly has a variety of goals in his grasp as the sprint cars of the California Racing Association and the midgets of the U. S. Auto Club Western States Series combine for the first non-winged Pacific Coast Nationals since 1985 at J. C. Agajanian's Ascot tonight and Saturday (Oct. 27-28).

First and foremost in Shuman's mind, of course, is defense of his season title in the 50-lap sprint car finale when the points are added to his now leading total in the Parnelli Jones Firestone/CRA Series. He gained a scant nine points as he finished third with Rip Williams of Yorba Linda fourth at Manzanita Speedway last Friday. Shuman now leads Rip by 18 and Jerry Meyer, the six-month front-runner until Oct. 14, by 34.

In addition to the points incentive the 50-lapper pays \$6,000 to win in the \$33,000 sprint car portion of the \$50,000 purse. Shuman, with two 50-lap victories in CRA this year, is also trying to become the second four-time winner of the PCN. Retired Dean Thompson of Carson won in 1979-80-82 and '85; Shuman in 1976-77 and '83.

Already recognized as one of the top winged performers of the last decade, Shuman has also captured the U. S. Nationals at Knoxville, Iowa in the pre-wing days (1979) and is one of 16 drivers to have won at least one race in a major association every year since 1980.

The latter group of 16 which include such luminaries as Doug Wolfgang, Ken Schrader, Rusty Wallace, and Darrel Waltrip, has two others in this high caliber weekend program. Rich Vogler of Indianapolis, most often a foe of Shuman in midgets and also the current USAC sprint car champion, and Chuck Gurney of Livermore, 1989 USAC Silver Crown titlist, are also members of the elite list.

Shuman, has the ride for the half-mile midget race that he used to finish third behind Gurney and Vogler last Thanksgiving Night. However, Shuman has copped the Turkey Night classic six times in the last 10 years.

Shuman's fellow Arizonan, Billy Boat of Phoenix, will be looking for his first Ascot victory ever after his third win at Manzanita Friday. Eddie Wirth of Hermosa Beach, who was second at Phoenix last week and Brad Noffsinger of Huntington Beach, who was sixth, are other strong 50-lap threats.

Besides Shuman and Vogler in midgets, the entries include former national champions Ron (Sleepy) Tripp of Costa Mesa, and Kevin Olson of Machesney Park, Ill., Indy 500 regulars Stan Fox of Janesville, Wis., and Billy Vukovich III of Fresno, and Western States point leader Robby Flock of City of Industry.

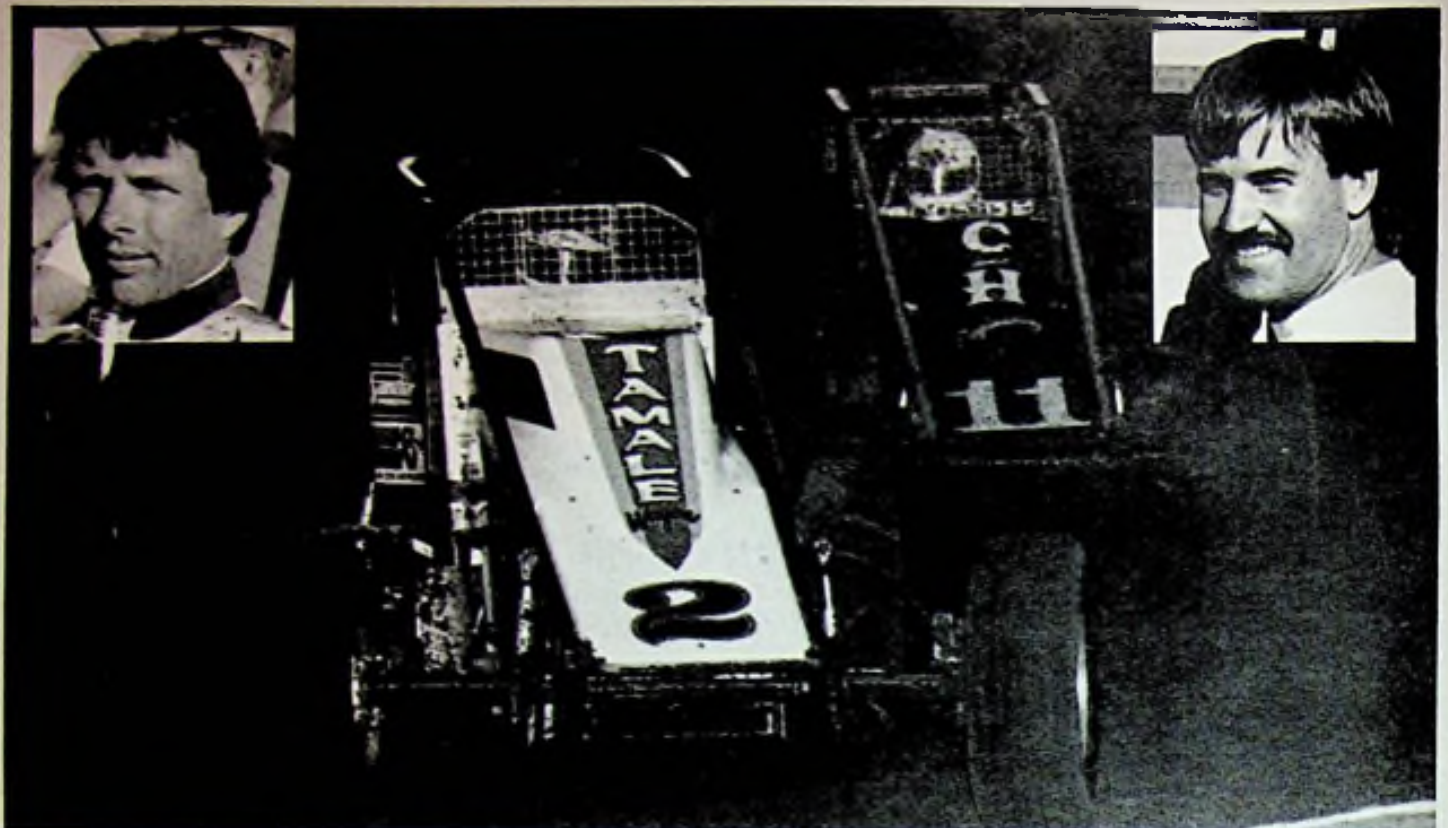

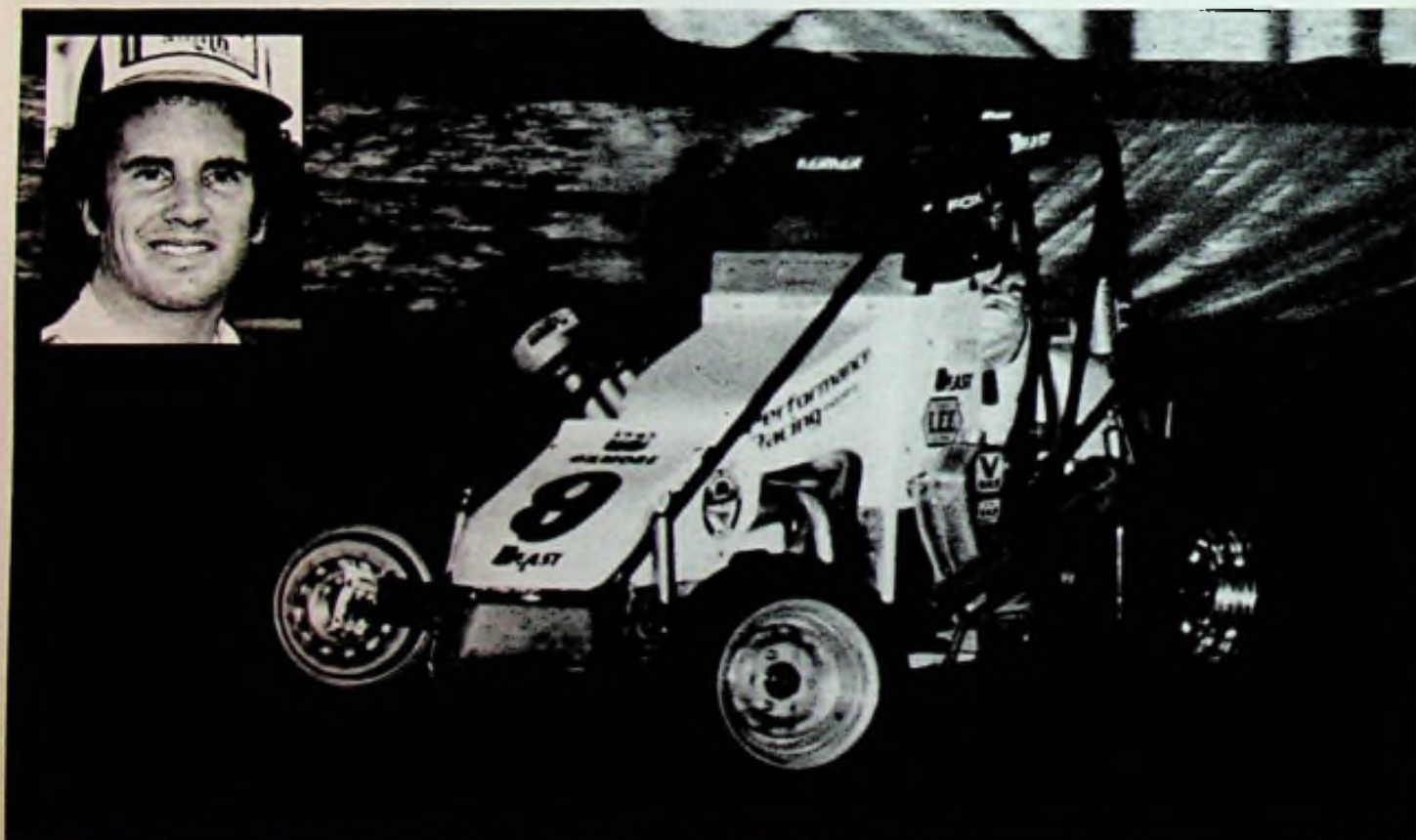

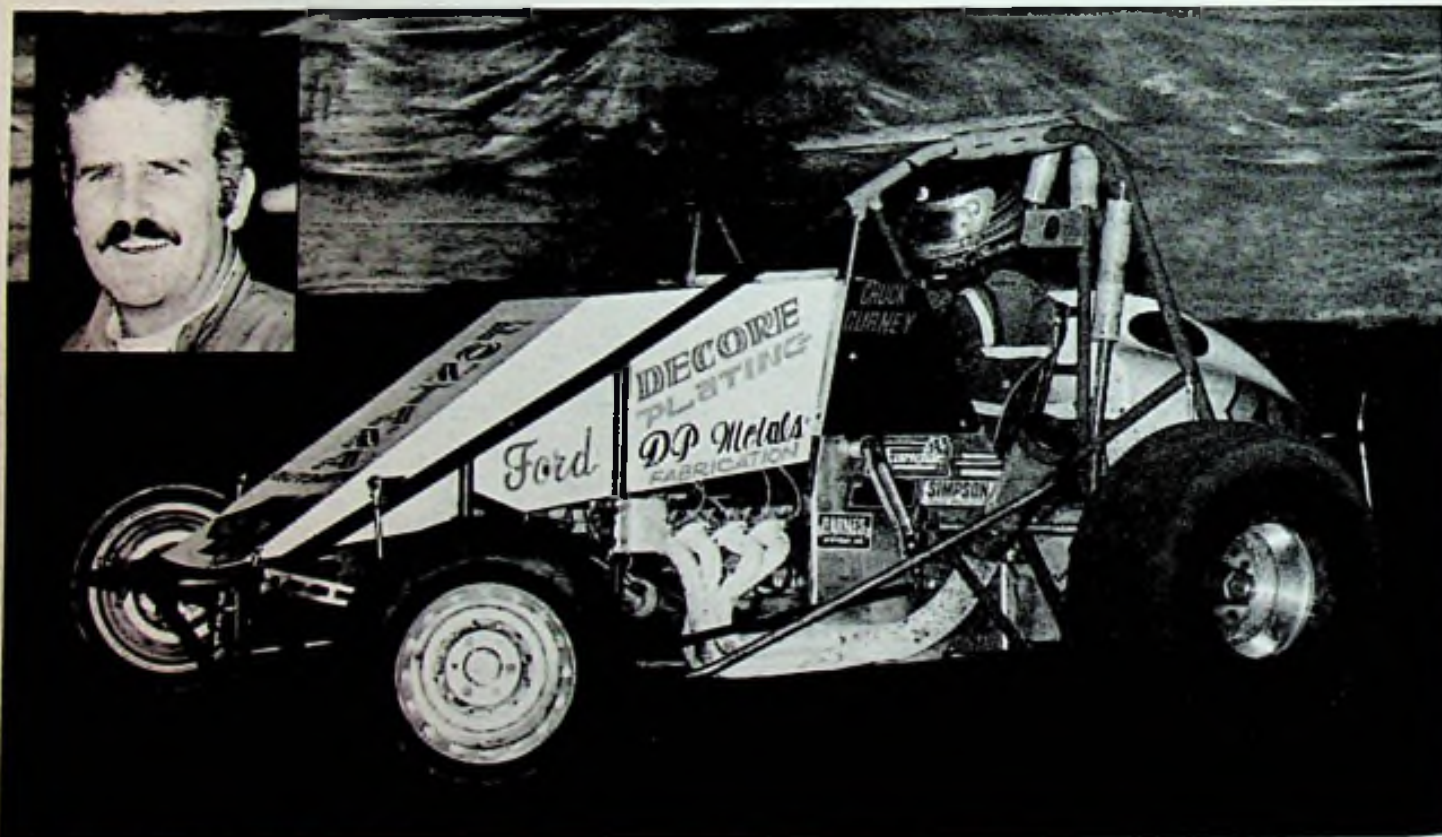

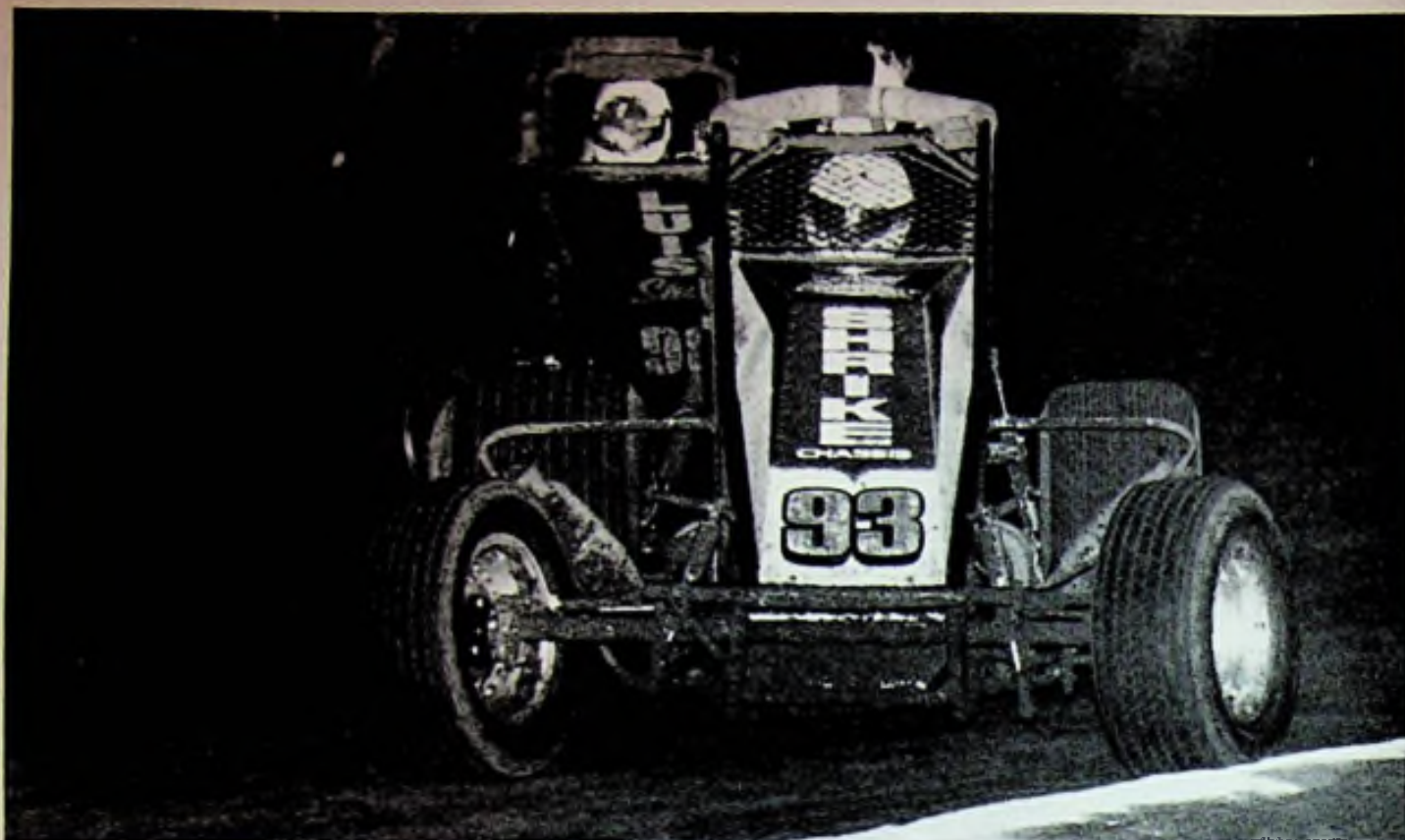

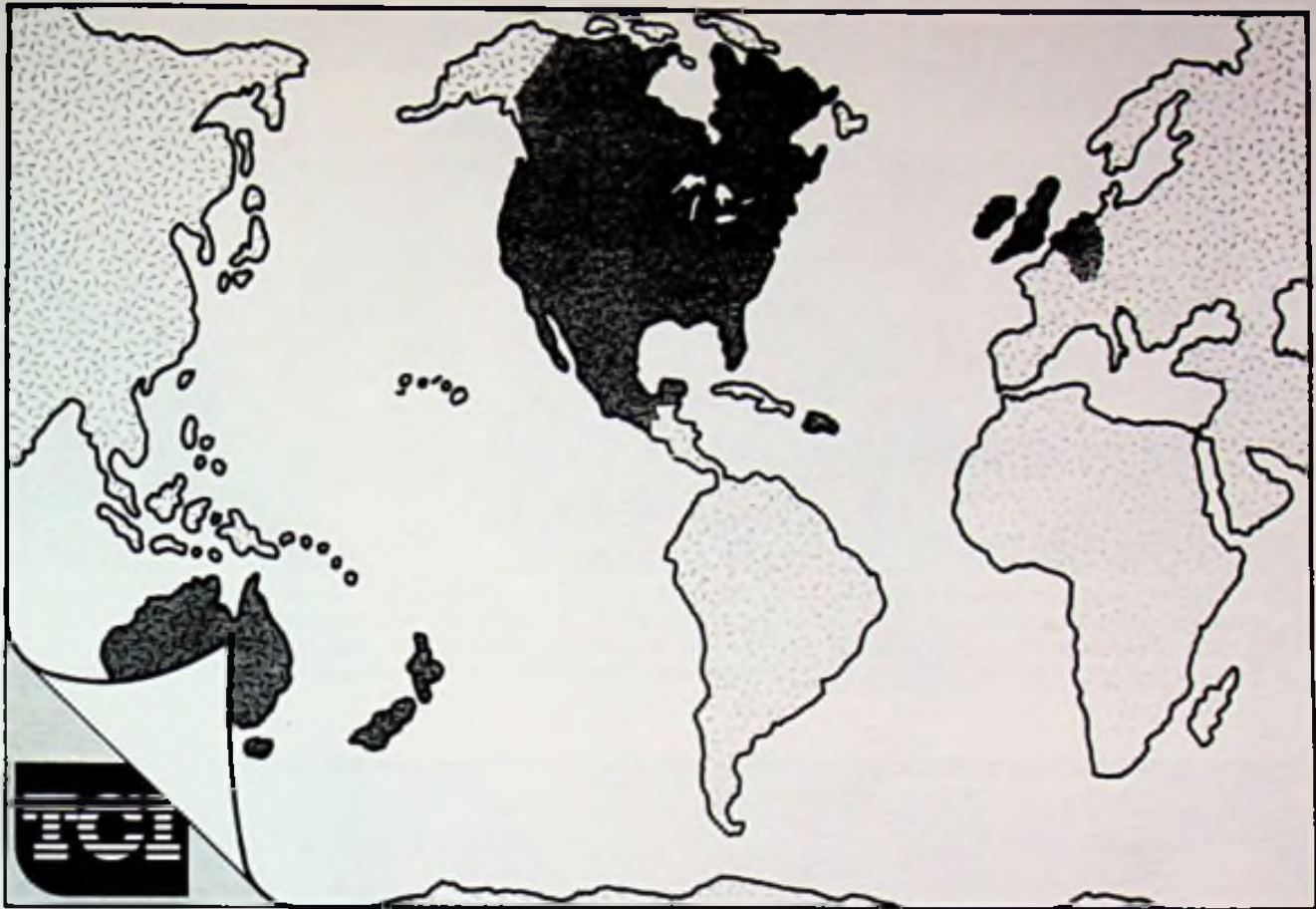

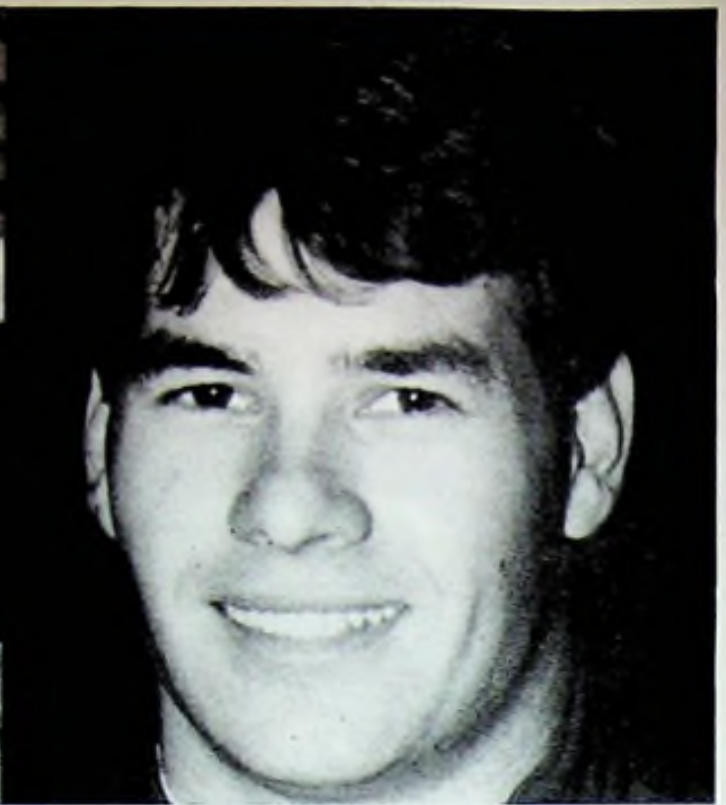
