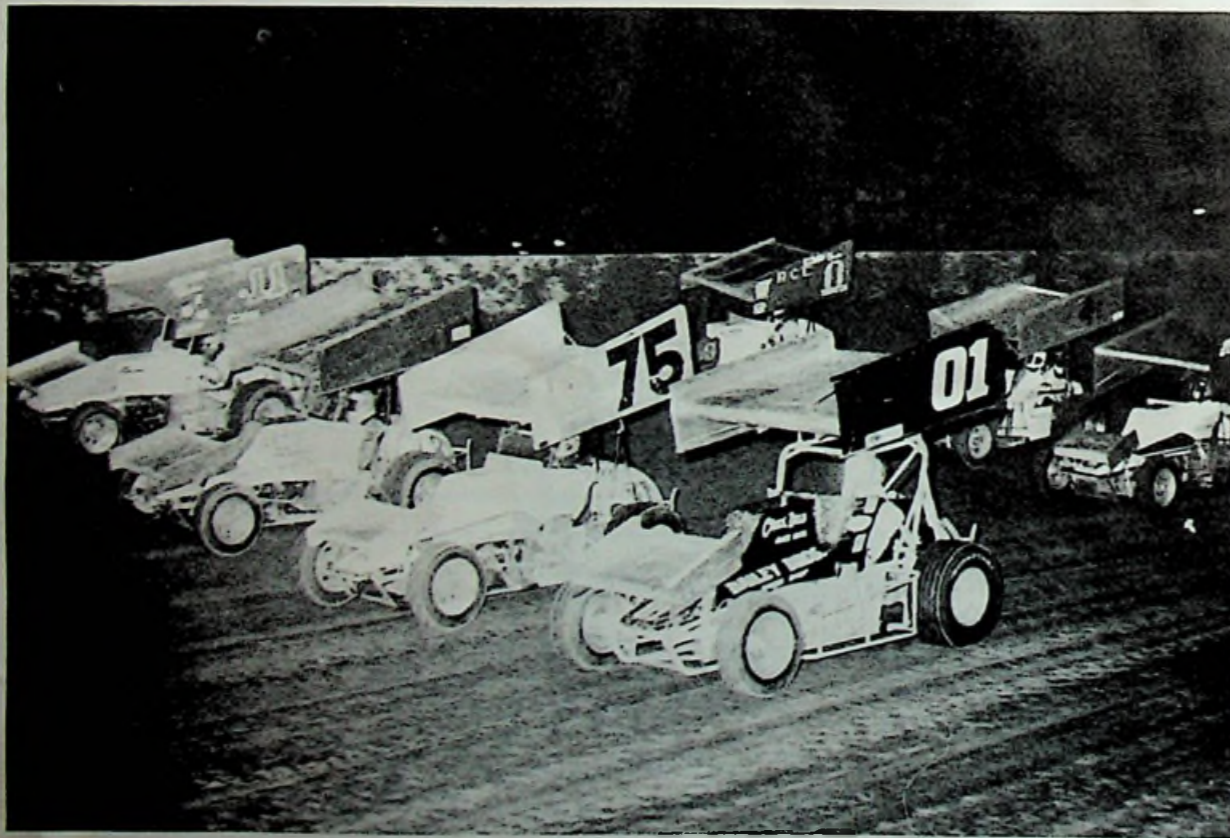

**STEVE KINSER**

Steve Kinser, 1978's "King of the Outlaws", is currently the number one point man, about 1,000 points ahead of second place Sammy Swindell. To date Steve has 22 feature wins on the Outlaw circuit as well as numerous seconds and thirds. He is 25 years old, single and hails from Bloomington, Indiana, where many other members of the Kinser family are involved with all facets of racing. His cousin, Sheldon, races an Indy type car; father, Bob, races sprints and is currently in 13th place in the World of Outlaw point standings. His brother, Randy, also races sprints in the Indiana area. In addition to this, his second cousin, Karl, is Steve's car owner and chief mechanic. Karl has been involved with auto racing for the past 24 years and for the last 12 years has owned the top sprinter in the country. Steve is well on the way to becoming the 1979 "King", and in addition to being the defending champion of the World of Outlaws, he is also defending his title at the Gold Cup, which he won last year.



**SAMMY SWINDELL**

23 year old, single, Sammy Swindell - from Memphis, Tennessee, is the World of Outlaws second place man. He has 10 feature wins on the circuit in his Federal Express #91. His wins this year include the mile at Indianapolis; New Bremen, Ohio; Dallas, Texas; and Winnipeg, Canada. In addition to 10 wins, he is also the top qualifier for the \$10,000. Busch Bash in October with nine fast times.



**RICK FERKEL**

Rick Ferkel, married, 39 years old, from Findlay, Ohio, is a household name in sprint racing. He has been involved in this sport for 14 years and has over 200 feature wins in his career. This year on the World of Outlaw circuit he is in third place and has five feature wins in spite of numerous mechanical difficulties throughout the year.

Doug Wolfgang from Sioux Falls, South Dakota, is 27 years old, married and the father of two. Wolfgang is the two time National Open champion at Knoxville, Iowa. His largest single win thus far in his career was at the World of Outlaw show at Champaign, Illinois, which paid \$10,000. to win. Since rejoining the circuit in the Speedway Motors 4X, he has been one of the hottest drivers around.
