

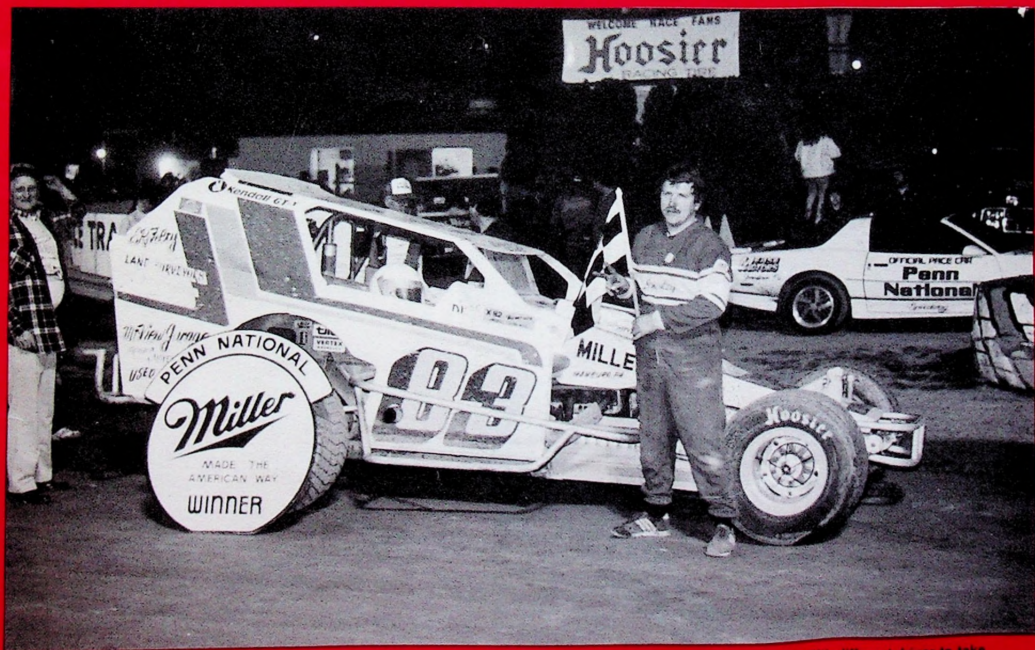

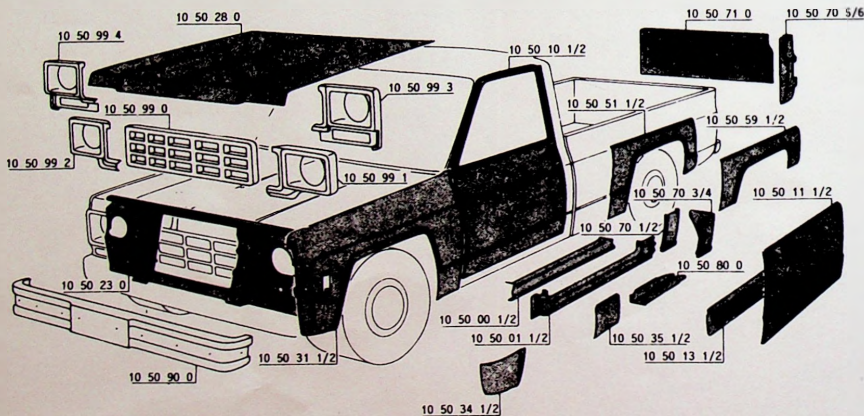

WARREN MAKES BIG COME BACK TO TAKE PENN NATIONAL SPEEDWAY VICTORY

GRANTVILLE, PA - Smokey Warren of Jonestown pulled off the victory Sunday evening at the Penn National Speedway after taking top honors in the 25 lap sportsman-modified feature event. The win for Smokey was a special one as last week he wound up upside down at the very start of the race and his car was badly damaged. A lot of hard work by Smokey and his pit crew put the Tobias chassis no. 83 back in the winners circle.

Scott Schaeffer of Birdsboro surly one of the most improved drivers this season led the first five laps of the feature event, but a caution flag for Jeff Bomgardner closed up the field. On the restart Warren blew by Schaeffer and built up a ten car length lead over Craig VonDohren who took over the second spot on lap eight.

A caution flag for Randy Fortna who stopped on the track with two laps to go gave VonDohren and Billy Pauch who was running third a shot at Warren. But at the checkered it was Warren by six car lengths. VonDohren drove a super race to nail down second with Pauch third and Ronnie Tobias fourth. Tobias had to come from the rear of the field after making an early race pit stop. Davey Wenger finished fifth after starting 16th with Dennis Bailey sixth Randy Masser seventh, Billy Schinkel eighth, Mike Nicholas ninth, and Ed Miller Jr rounding out the top ten.

Sportsman-modified heat race winners for the 39 cars on hand went to VonDohren, Dave Schoffstall and Jack Follweiler. The consy went to Wenger and the Cash Dash went to Von Dohren.

The 15 lap street stock feature went to Larry Graver. The non stop race went nip and tuck right down to the wire between Graver and a host of drivers. Second spot went to Charlie Sorokach with Scott Thunberg third. Completing the top five were Brian Strand, Mike Clay. Sixth through tenth went to Ron Hibshman, Mike Killian, Lee Miller, Jerry Schott and Scott Albert.

Street stock heat race winners were Thunberg, Sorokach and Graver. Strand won the consy and Graver also won the Cash Dash.

The entire show was over at 10:10.

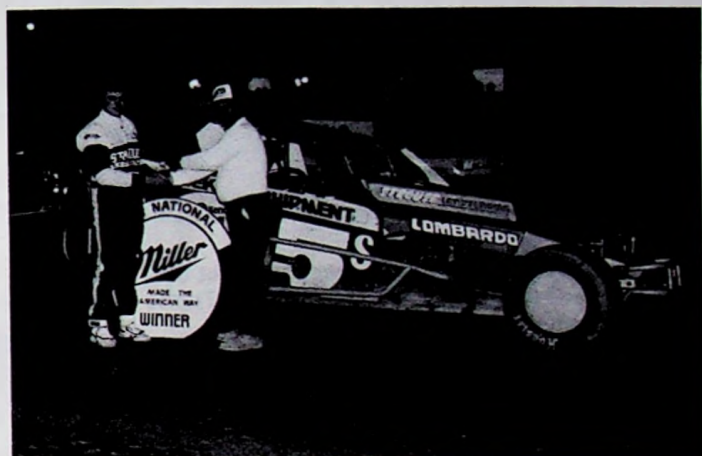

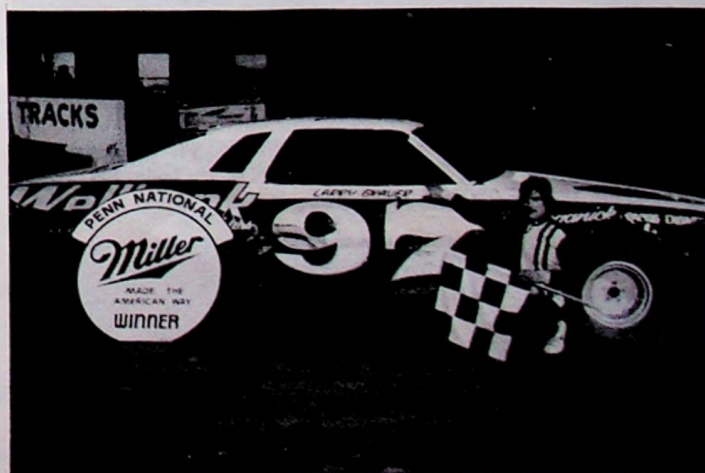

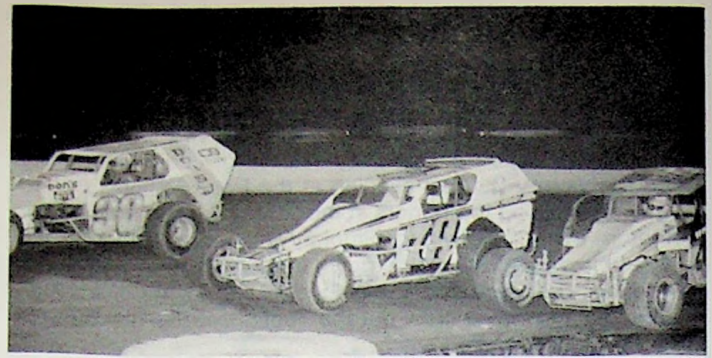

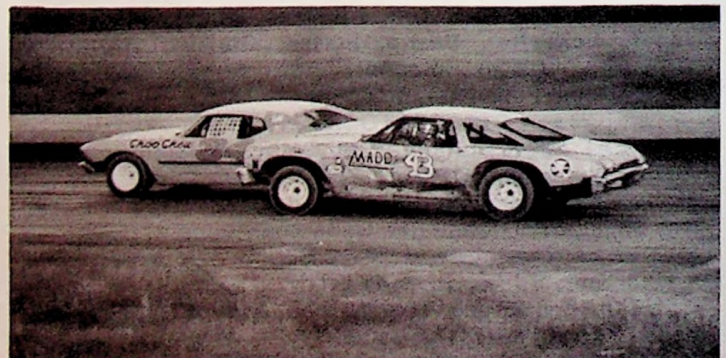

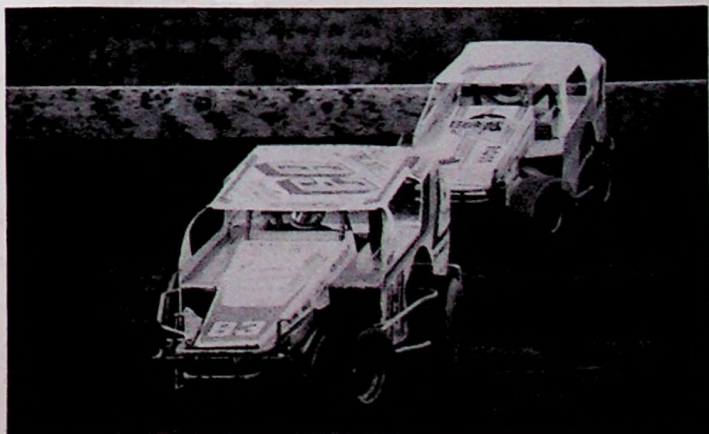

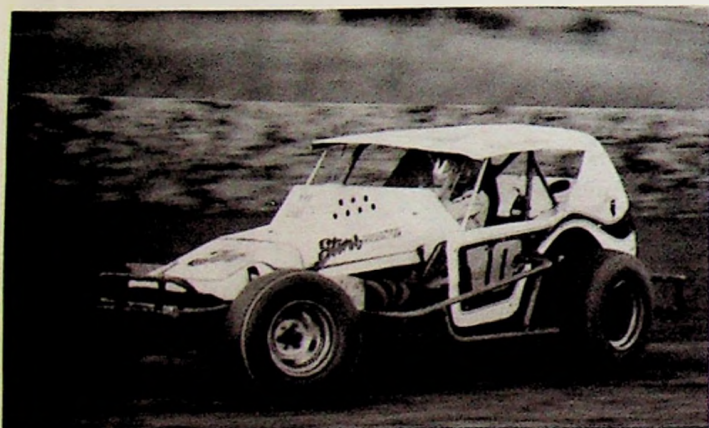

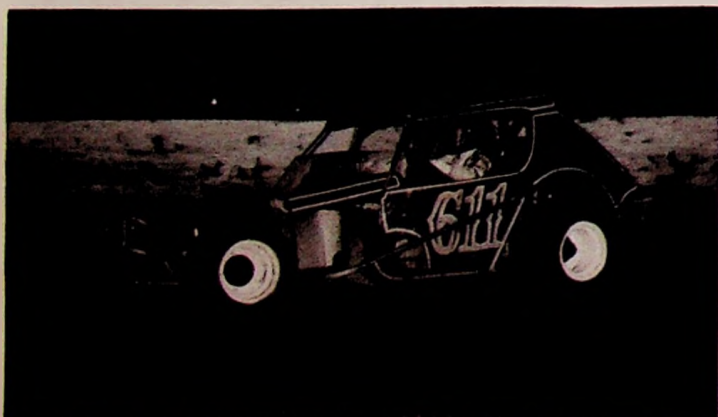

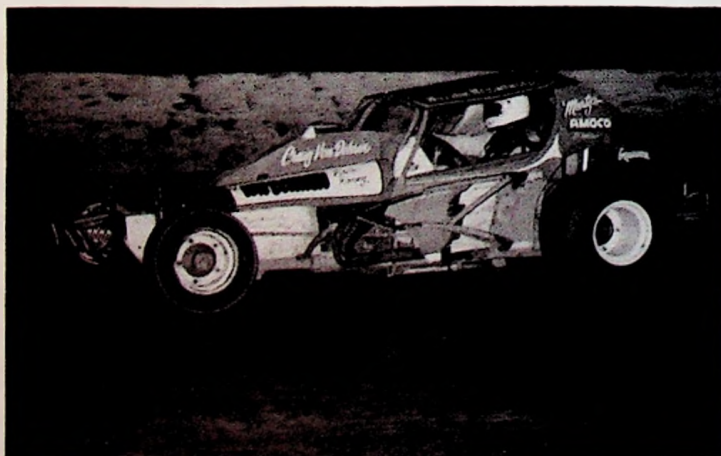

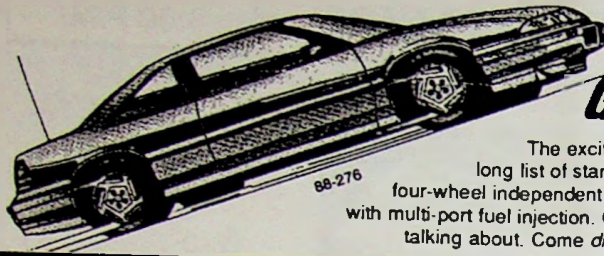

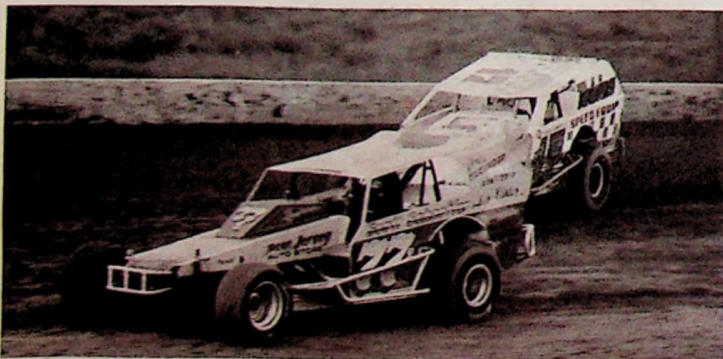

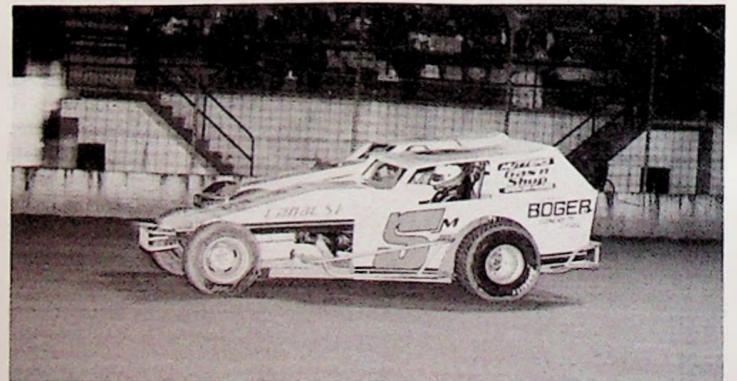

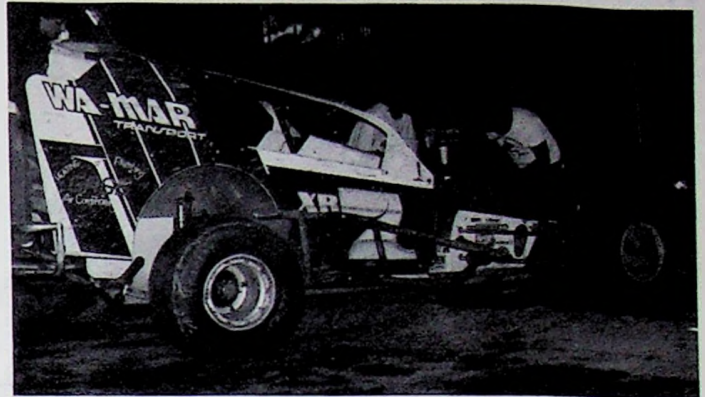

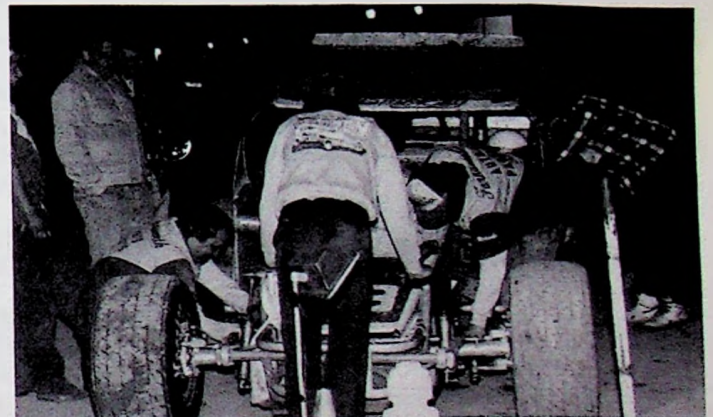
